

Contract to Host a PCLA Show

This contract is between the PCLA and Show Coordinator/Administrator/Administration. By signing this contract both parties (PCLA and Show) agree to the following criteria:

The Show Will:

1. Host a show for exhibitors between the ages of 8 and 21 as of the current year.
2. Register any youth willing to be a PCLA member.
3. Conduct show in relationship with PCLA guidelines.
 - a. Showmanship based on three age divisions.
 - i. Juniors – 8 to 11 years of age.
 - ii. Intermediates – 12 to 15 years of age.
 - iii. Seniors – 16 to 21 years of age.
 1. Straight Classes – Placings 1-10 and list of all other participating exhibitors in each age division.
 2. Heat Classes – Placings 1-5, list of exhibitors who advanced to finals, and a list of all other participating exhibitors.
 - b. Skill-a-thons based on three age divisions.
 - i. Juniors – 8 to 11 years of age.
 - ii. Intermediates – 12 to 15 years of age.
 - iii. Seniors – 16 to 21 years of age.
 1. It is customary to use the same test for each age division.
 2. The show is responsible to develop a tie breaker system.
 3. Placings 1-10 and a list of all other participating exhibitors in each age division.
 - c. Type Classes based on weight or breed.
 - i. Class – Placings 1-10 and
 - ii. Include division champions and reserve champions.
 - iii. Include Champion and Reserve Champion.
4. **Submit complete results to Eric Cowden within three days of the show. Send to ecowden@state.pa.us**

The PCLA Will:

1. Provide a master copy of the class entry cards.
2. Provide an excel (spread sheet) to use to break classes and record results.
3. Post your show entry form and show results on our website.
4. List your show date in Newsletter.
5. Calculate points for your show.
6. Provide you with a list of current members prior to your show.
7. Provide guidance and assistance as needed or requested.
8. Provide By-laws and show rules for conducting your show.

1. **There is a \$100 per show sanction fee. Please make payable to PCLA and include with application. \$50 will be reimbursed to the show if show is conducted in accordance to stated agreement (above contract).**
2. PCLA will only sanction one show per date.
3. PCLA will award sanctions to shows that are in good standing from prior year first.
4. PCLA will award open dates on a first come first serve basis.
5. Failure to comply with PCLA sanctioning and rules may result in dismissal from the PCLA show circuit.
6. A representative of your show must be present at the February 21st, 2010 Directors Meeting. The meeting will be held at the Denny's Restaurant at the Bedford Turnpike Exit at 1:00 PM.
7. Notifications will occur on February 21st.
