**ALL ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION ISSUED IN THE LAST 30 DAYS AND SIGNED BY AN ACCREDITED VETERINARIAN. Please observe all state regulations regarding blood work.**

**WEIGH-INS:** pigs 7:30am-9:30; goats 9:45am-11:15am; lambs 10:30am-12.  
**SHOW SCHEDULE:** PIGS WILL START WITH SHOWMANSHIP AT 10:30AM IN THE SALE BARN. GOATS WILL SHOW IN THE LARGE ARENA BEGINNING WITH TYPE CLASSES AT NOON. LAMBS WILL FOLLOW GOATS.

**AGES:** ALL AGES ARE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2010  
Peewee-8 and under, not eligible for type classes, everyone gets a prize  
*Novice-8 and under, eligible for type classes, must be able to show unassisted, no PACLA points will be awarded for this division*

*Junior-8-11*

*Intermediate-12-15*

*Senior-16-21*

**SKILLATHON:** Will be open from 11am until 2pm. Assistance will be available as needed. *You do not need to be exhibiting an animal to participate*

***GENERAL RULES:***

1. Show is open to all youth 21 & under as of 1-1-10.
2. There is no limit to the number of animals you can exhibit.
3. Entries will be accepted until the close of scales.
4. No refunds for no-shows.
5. Money will be prorated in classes with less than 10 entries.
6. There will be no weight limits.
7. Classes will be divided as evenly as possible.
8. All lambs and goats must be sheared or clipped within 10 days of show to be weighed.
9. Lambs and pigs will be divided into three weight divisions of three classes each. Goats will be divided into three weight divisions of two classes each. The show is open to females and castrated males of each species.
10. BYO bedding. Please clean your pen before you leave.
11. Animals showing signs of contagious or infectious disease or external parasites will not be allowed to show. The discretion of the show committee prevails.
12. All lambs and kids must have a full set of lamb's/kid's teeth, respectively.
13. All lambs and doe kids must have an official USDA/APHIS ear tag or tattoo.
14. All animals must be identified by ear tag or tattoo. Pigs may be identified by ear notch.
